2009 is the United Nations International Year of Reconciliation, but the concept of reconciliation is a difficult and complex one that many people struggle to understand. The Called to be Peacemakers conference will explain what reconciliation is, its uses in the past and present, and how it can apply to our lives.

This residential weekend event is for 18 to 30 (ish) year olds who are interested, active and/or engaged in peace and conflict issues. With expert speakers and skills training, the event provides an opportunity to join a community of like-minded individuals from across the UK.

The conference is being held at the Community for Reconciliation, Birmingham and is subsidised to allow as many people to attend as possible. A limited number of travel bursaries and subsidised places are available. Places are £45 if booked before 1 October 2009 (£55 after). The weekend is run by Fellowship of Reconciliation, England (www.for.org.uk).
