### **Oxford Train Station—10 minute walk**

Exit the station from Platform 1. Once outside, walk to main road. Turn left. At crossing, cross over the Botley Road (two stage crossing). Turn right off the Botley Road down Hollybush Row. You will pass the Jam Factory arts cafe on your right. Take the 2nd left into St Thomas' Street. Turn right at the Brewery Gate pub onto Paradise Street. Peace House is on your right after you have crossed the bridge.

### **Parking**

There are some parking bays. During office hours these are reserved for staff and deliveries. **By informal arrangement** they can be used by organisers and speakers for evening events if they are available.

### Henry Hodgkin Room (up to 30 people)

*This space is an ideal flexible venue in central Oxford for anything from committee meetings to public lectures, workshops to meditation groups, yoga to symposia.*



**Facilities for meetings, symposia, and workshops:** White board, 30 chairs, 5 tables, dimmable lighting, IT equipment, mobile facilities for refreshments, projector screen, kitchen access, some day/evening parking for facilitators by agreement, some storage space by agreement, natural light.

**Facilities for smaller groups:** Dimmable uplighters, flexible open-plan floor space, quiet yet central location, discrete access to building, limited evening parking, storage space.

**Times:** Any time of day or night, unless already booked.

**£10 per hour charity / £25 business**

### FoR Library (up to 10 people)

*Ideal for small group work, meetings or interviews.*

Seating for around 5 people, 2 tables, overhead lighting, natural light, access to kitchen/toilets.

**Times:** Use during office hours only.

**£8 charity/ £15 business, or £15/£30 if used with Henry Hodgkin Room together.**
